- d) All the expenses of serial no 3 of this visit will be borne by Bangladesh Atomic Energy Regulatory Authority (BAERA).
- e) They will leave Dhaka for Moscow on 15 June 2017 or on a nearby date and will leave Russian Federation for Bangladesh on 18 June 2017 or on a nearby date.
